Care and Cleaning of your ocarina

In order to protect the look and feel of your ocarina, please follow these care and cleaning guidelines



- ✓ Always use a soft cloth when cleaning the ocarina.
- ✓ Wipe gently with the cloth. Dampen if needed with warm soapy water.
- ✓ Allow the ocarina to dry completely before storing in a closed container.
- ✓ Clean the wind way with a sharp puff of air. Only if the wind way becomes obstructed, clear with a soft coated pipe cleaner.



- Never use a scouring pad or harsh abrasives.
- Do not immerse or soak the ocarina when cleaning.
- Never insert metal objects into the mouth piece.
